I would ask somebody running IDL on SPARC Solaris 2.6 to do the following and tell me if the problem is on my computer or my intallation.

Run IDL
? (to get the help window)
click on "contents"
click on "index"
Type "device"
Choose "DEVICE procedure"
on the small window, choose "Table of IDL devices"
once you have that help in the window, go to the top and click on
"Keywords Accepted by the IDL Device"
Choose ENCAPSULATED or (PS) next to ENCAPSULATED.

On 2 of the computers (different installation) I have access, after this last choice, it just got me out of X-window and prompt me to the Login one.

Has anybody had similar problem?

It may be the combination of Solaris 2.6 and IDL 5.2.
