> How can I place a title on the window opened with TVIMAGE?

TVIMAGE doesn't open windows. In fact, none of my graphics display programs open windows if I can figure out a way to avoid it. I try to write programs that display in *any* open window, including those in the Z-graphics buffer and in a PostScript file. It's the only way I know to write device-independent code. (Which is one of the reasons you are using TVIMAGE, I presume.) :-)

I'd try something like this:

```
Window, /Free, Title='Image Window'  
TVImage, image
```
