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I have been having a heck of a time trying to get basic colors to work with plot. For example, after entering the program fresh I type

```
plot, [0,1,2,3,4,5], [0,2,4,6,8,10]  
loadct, 0  
tek_color  
plot, [0,1,2,3,4,5], [0,2,4,6,8,10], color=1
```

and my original plot disappears. The reason is that instead of the tek_color color table, a linear red color table has been loaded. It has color 0 = (0,0,0) and color 255 = (255,0,0) with a linear ramp in between.

It is not until I execute something like the IDL demo that tek_color works as expected. That is, color 1 = white, color 2 = red, etc.

I'm sure it's something basic that I'm missing. But what?
