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Hi Specialists,

several days ago I observed that if one chooses the background to be white, the background of the Z-buffer picture will be blue. I could fix it at least by choosing the background to be 254, not to be 255 and it worked.

But now there is another problem and I don't know how to fix it after working on it for hours. It works fine, but not with the Z-buffer:

I want to create a contour-plot as a combination of filled contours and line-plots with white and black lines respectively:

But the Z-buffer shows only the filled contour-plot. The result is the same as if I delete the second and third contour-instruction.

By the way changing the thickness of the lines with !p.thick doesn't affect the z-buffer-image, but the "normal" image...

The question is: How can I manage this problem???
